The Nimbin Community Disaster Plan

The Disaster Plan was developed in 2021 and revised in 2023 to increase the resilience of the Nimbin community against natural disasters. It is a Community-led Plan and there are lots of ways you can become involved.

The Plan covers strategies involving community-level Preparation for, Response to and Recovery from natural disasters. You can view/download the Disaster Plan on the NNIC website www.nnic.org.au (see the Disasters tab).

The Nimbin Disaster Resilience Group oversees the implementation of the Plan. To join this grassroots community group contact nimbindisasterresiliencegroup@gmail.com

The Nimbin Emergency Radio Network (NERN) has been set up in case of loss of normal communications during/after a disaster. There are 17 NERN locations. To find the one nearest to you, check the NNIC website.

Community Care Teams (CCT): the aim is for a CCT of at least 5 members to work in each of the 17 NERN locations to undertake welfare checks of residents in their neighbourhoods following a disaster. To join your local CCT, see the EOI form on the NNIC website or contact admin@nnic.org.au

When a Natural Disaster is declared by the State Government this triggers a range of actions including the establishment of evacuation centres by the NSW Department of Communities and Justice and the release of disaster relief funding.
